1. Call to Order – Mr. Abzug called the meeting to order at 1:35 p.m.
2. Approval of Agenda – The agenda was approved as presented.
3. Approval of Minutes – The minutes of the meeting of November 4, 2009, were approved as written.
4. Chairman's Comments – The chair welcomed everyone to the meeting and introduced new member David Brown and visitor Bernice Felix. Ms. Felix will be replacing Howard Levenson who has resigned from the committee.
5. General Manager's Report – Mr. Ellis presented the May General Manager's Report and responded to all questions and comments.
6. Old Business –
 - a. Drainage Issue – Last fall two drains were opened up on the old courts. This appears to have eliminated the problem of subsurface water coming through the cracks.
 - b. Gazebo Steps - A committee member said that the stripes had not yet been painted on the lower steps of gazebo. Mr. Ellis said he would have them painted.
7. New Business –

- a. Court Resurfacing and Repainting – Work by American Tennis Courts should begin in about a week; the courts will be shut down approximately a week assuming the weather remains warm and dry.
 - i. Old Courts - The cracks will be repaired and bad cracks will be covered with an elastic membrane. Two coats of paint will then be applied.
 - ii. New Courts - Pressure washing has been done. The surface is in good enough condition that resurfacing is not necessary. Two coats of paint will be applied.

- b. Pickle Ball - Pickle ball players are not to use the tennis courts without permission from the Tennis Advisory Committee.
